Since 1965, the Bay Area Rescue Mission has been dedicated to helping the homeless and desperately needy men, women, and children of the greater Bay Area. The Rescue Mission has been able to provide more than 20,000,000 meals and 4,750,000 bed nights of shelter. In addition, countless numbers of people have received the assistance they needed to permanently change their lives. In recent years, the number of women and children coming to the Bay Area Rescue Mission for help has significantly grown beyond the resources of their current facilities.

In 2010 the Bay Area Rescue Mission Board of Directors began the process of assessing how we could best alleviate the shortcomings of our current facilities and subsequently launched the Bridge of Hope Project. The Bridge of Hope Center will significantly increase our capacity to provide comprehensive continuum of care programs to the Bay Area's most vulnerable population, homeless women and children. Bridge of Hope will provide a safe, loving and nurturing environment for women and children to rebuild their lives and help to break the perpetual cycle of homelessness through their proven system to restore the whole person. The Bridge of Hope will restore dignity and self-worth to the women and children through physical, mental, spiritual, educational, job and life-skills training that will allow them to break free and become self-sufficient and productive members of society.

Bridge of Hope will provide:

- Housing for an additional 114 women and children
- 26 studio-type living areas
- Critical job skills training and services needed to work towards self-sufficiency and permanent housing.
