



-HOWDY NEIGHBOR- UNIVERSITY BLVD. BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION



University Blvd. bridge over DNT closed to traffic beginning October 8.

NTTA will resurface the University Boulevard bridge over the Dallas North Tollway (DNT) as part of regularly scheduled maintenance. This work includes concrete removal and placing a new concrete surface. Construction will begin Saturday, Oct. 8, and go continuously for approximately five days.

WHY: This work is part of NTTA's continuing effort to maintain the reliable, high-quality roads our customers expect.

WHERE: Work area is limited to the University Boulevard bridge directly above the DNT.

WHEN WORK WILL OCCUR: Closure is scheduled to begin early Saturday, October 8. Weather permitting, work will take approximately five days. No overnight bridge work is anticipated, but the bridge will be closed until the work is completed. All closures are subject to weather conditions and, if necessary, will be postponed.

WHAT YOU MAY SEE: Drivers can expect to see various construction vehicles, including water trucks and concrete mixers. Traffic control, including barrels and detour signage, will be in place.

WHAT YOU MAY HEAR: Concrete deck removal will be loud. Expect to hear more noise during the day on Saturday and Sunday while this work is underway.

SAFETY NOTE: Be aware of fenced-off construction areas, watch for construction signage, and drive with caution. For your safety, please stay away from construction, storage sites and equipment. If you see something unusual or unsafe, dial #999 to reach NTTA's Safety Operations Center 24 hours a day.
