- NO DOGS WILL BE ADMITTED WITHOUT PROOF OF VACCINATIONS.

\*PLEASE NOTE - Even if your dog is registered with the city, you still must attach/present proof of vaccines. The Parks Dept. <u>DOES NOT</u> have access to your registration records.

- Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries/damages caused by them.
- Dogs whose behavior is unruly or hazardous to other participants may be requested to leave.
- Dog waste must be cleaned up by owners and disposed of properly.
- All dogs must be on a leash while not in the pool.
- A tagged collar must be on dogs at ALL times.
- No electric, pinch, spike, and/or choke collars are allowed.
- Dog owners must closely supervise their dog at all times, and may not leave their dog unattended while leaving the pool premises.
- Dogs must be under control at all times.
- Each handler/owner is limited to no more than two (2) dogs.
- While swimming in the pool, only one human friend is allowed to accompany the dog.
- Children under age seven (7) years of age must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- The following are not allowed in the pool area:
  - Female dogs in heat
  - Aggressive dogs
  - Puppies under six (6) months of age
  - Dogs that are not in good health
  - Animals other than dogs
  - Alcoholic beverages, food, glass containers
  - NO rawhides, bones or dog treats
  - Bicycles, skateboards, roller-skates/blades, or any motorized devices (except wheelchairs)
  - Small toys that could be a choking hazard to dogs.
