Dear Voter,

Ohio has been a national leader in making it easy to vote and hard to cheat. For more than 15 years, voters have had a choice in how and when they cast a ballot. If you choose not to vote in person, state law allows you to vote securely by mail.

The next statewide election is coming up on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. If you're registered to vote and prefer to vote by mail, please complete the absentee ballot request form on the back of this letter. Be sure to provide all the required information, sign it, and include your phone number and/or email address in case any follow-up is required.

Don't wait. To accommodate for possible postal delays, we recommend that you return the form to your **county board of elections no later than October 21, 2022**. Once you do, you can track the secure processing of your request and ballot at [VoteOhio.gov/Track](https://VoteOhio.gov/Track).

Remember, if you don't wish to vote securely by mail, you can still vote in person – either at your county board of elections beginning October 12, 2022 or at your local polling location on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2022.

**Make sure your voice is heard!** Take your right and responsibility as a citizen seriously and VOTE!

- I understand that if an absentee ballot is mailed to me and I change my mind and go to my polling place to vote on Election Day, I will be required to vote a provisional ballot.
- I understand that if I do not provide the board with all of the required information, my application cannot be processed.
- I hereby declare, under penalty of election falsification, that I am a qualified elector and the statements above are true.
