Re: Referral for Possible Election Law Violations

Dear Attorney General Yost,

As Ohio's chief elections officer, I have a duty to ensure the accuracy, accessibility and security of our elections. That's why I've made it a point to partner with other states to maintain more accurate voter lists.

This partnership has allowed us to review voter history data and investigate potential cases of fraud where a voter appears to have cast a ballot in two states in the same election. The review utilized the collected data to conduct a cross-match of voter history among the partner states. Each potential violation was then investigated individually in coordination with the Secretary of State's office in that state.

As a result of this review at this time, my office identified four individuals who appear to have voted in Ohio after casting a ballot in a different state in the same election. I included documentation with this letter that my office reviewed regarding each of these individuals, and I'm referring this information to your office for additional action pursuant to your authority in R.C. 109.54(A) and 109.95. I have also referred these four individuals to the county prosecutor's office in the relevant counties.

Thanks to these and other safeguards, fraud and suppression are exceedingly rare; however, neither is acceptable, even in rare or isolated instances. The only way to continue this high standard of election integrity is by committing to enforce the law whenever evidence suggests it might've been broken. The legitimacy of our elections depends on the consistent enforcement of the laws governing them. For that reason, I'm confident you'll give this matter the attention it deserves by acting quickly to complete your investigations and pursuing prosecution as warranted.
