## Community Center

Welcome, Check-in, and refer clients to appropriate departments. Help oversee our guests in the waiting area. Sort and hand out mail to our guests. Help create initial intakes for new guests. The Help Desk assists with referrals for guest needs, and a computer and phone are available. On-going volunteers are welcome and encouraged.

## Men's Center

Help guests with showers and laundry facilities.

## Women's Center

Help guests with showers, laundry facilities, and female/family focused-referral services that best fit guest's needs.

## Clothing Closet

Help clothing insecure guests to access donated clothing free of charge. Help organize the closet and donated clothes.

## Dining Room

Help fight hunger in Oakland! The shift begins at 8:30 am. and goes on until 12:30 pm. Lunch is served to our guests between 10:45 am.-12:45 pm. from Tuesday through Saturday. Duties include: Helping serve food/beverages, assembling and packing lunches, washing and drying dishes, cleaning tables, organizing storage spaces, and cleaning after lunch. We have a strong community of dedicated volunteers that come regularly; we would love to add to that! On-going volunteers are welcome and encouraged.

## Overnight Shelter

The North County Shelter is open to individuals with vouchers. Drop-ins may also be accommodated if there are available beds. The shift is between 5:00 pm – 10:00 pm.
