We follow in the tradition of our founder, Blessed Frederic Ozanam, and our patron, St. Vincent de Paul.

We believe:

- in the dignity of the human person.
- in the identification of Jesus with the poor.
- that our primary concern is charity and social justice, especially to those living on the margins

Our works include:

- Serving those in need in our parish and the surrounding community including families with children, the working poor, the jobless, the disabled, the homeless, and the lonely.
- Providing financial assistance primarily for food, utility bills, rental assistance, transportation, and for other household needs.
- Referring neighbors to additional service organizations.
- Listening and providing spiritual and moral support.

- The Society of St. Vincent de Paul was founded in 1833 by Blessed Frederic Ozanam.
- It is named after St. Vincent de Paul, a priest in 17th Century Paris, who devoted his life to the poor.

Phone Duty:

From Monday through Friday, members answer calls for assistance. They visit neighbors during the day, making home visits while providing food, gift cards, and other help. Phone duty rotates, with members volunteering _____ days a month.

- **St. Vincent de Paul Dining Room:** Members are invited to serve at the SVdP Dining Room in Oakland throughout the year
- **Holiday Food Distribution:** Members assist with gift cards and food give-away at Thanksgiving and Christmas holidays.
- **Serving the Homeless** with food, goods, and resources, on weekends and other times.
- **Our Parishioners** benefit the conference with prayers, food, gift cards, and funds. Thank you!
- **No work of charity, justice, and kindness** is foreign to the works of the Conference of St. Vincent de Paul.

VINCENTIAN ROLE...

Our primary role is not to pay the bills, furnish the groceries, or clothe someone. The role of the Vincentian is to provide loving and compassionate interest to individuals. If that interest calls for food, clothing, or other assistance, so be it.

However, it is in loving where the contact with Christ emerges. That contact with Christ is what separates the Society of St. Vincent de Paul from just another agency.

When Vincentians see Jesus in the poor, they are moved to service.
