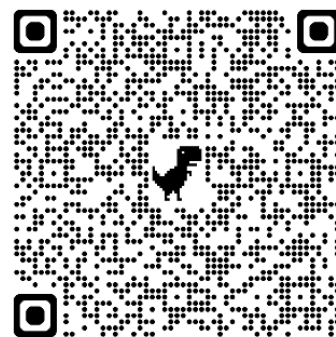
Join our interactive workshop designed specifically for early childhood educators!

- Grow age-appropriate communication skills



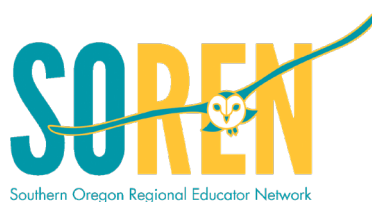
