## NEW RESTRICTIONS

Due to the recent outbreak of Covid-19, and the arrival of the new Omicron variant, the province has stated new restrictions taking effect Friday, Dec. 17th. We ask everyone to read carefully through the following, and follow the rules as advised by NS Public Health and Bishop Kirkpatrick.

- + Return to physical distance requirements of 6 feet between individuals or between groups of no more than 20 people from the same household or pre-established close social group.
- + Return to gathering limit of 50% or a maximum of 150 indoors.
- + Masking is required throughout services, whether people are seated or not, except for officiants or singers when they are speaking or singing.

**We WILL NOT be taking registrations for any of the upcoming masses. Attendance will be on a first come, first served basis.**
