On this day, the children bring from home their Christ-child figures, and returning home the figure is set safely out of sight for the remainder of Advent until happily placed in the creche with the arrival of Christmas. On the Third Sunday of Advent, parishioners are invited to bring their Christ Child from their nativity scene for the blessing that will take place during the final blessing.
