UPDATE ON THE RESTORATION OF THE SAINTS

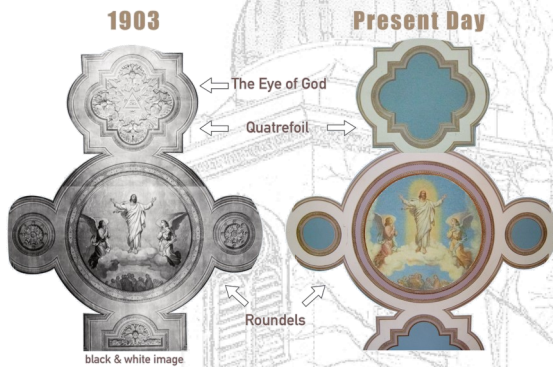
We are approaching the last month of the restoration of Saint Simon, Saint Thaddeus, Saint James the Lesser, and Saint Thomas.
