RESTORATION PROJECT

The next round of the Restoration Project has started. This will be the sixth consecutive year the Parish has been able to bring in the restoration team. This year, the restorers will finish the remainder three Saints on the East side of the church.



UPDATE: This week, the restorers worked on securing the peeling paint onto the walls. This process consists of steaming and gluing the peeling pieces. This is extremely important as Leduc's layers are amongst those

layers of paint flaking off the walls. Salvaging the peeling paint means salvaging the original art work.
