Hiking

Take your pick of Shrine Mont trails. <http://visitshenandoahcounty.com/wp-content/uploads/2017/02/ShrineMont-Hiking-Map.pdf> There are seven trails on the map and trips range from an easy 6 tenths of a mile round trip to a 4 mile (round trip) rigorous hike lasting 3 to 5 hours.

- We recommend the hike to the cross, which is rated “moderate,” generally takes 1 to 1½ hours and includes the stations of the cross and resting places.

Labyrinth Walking

The Labyrinth is located adjacent to the Shrine area. A walking spiritual exercise offering a contemplative reflective time. Fishing

Several sites to tempt your fishing aspirations

- The pond behind Maryland House. “Catch and Release” small fish such as perch. No fishing license required.
- Nearby Fishing Stream. More challenging opportunity. Fishing license required.
- Tomahawk Pond. Good fishing here on National Park property. Located four miles up main road from Shrine Mont. Fishing license required.



Local Spots for Visiting/Touring (all within the Shrine Mont/Basye/Mt. Jackson area)

- Wineries in Mt. Jackson

Tasting and touring opportunities at these two nearby wineries. The reviews are great. Go Taste and See but be sure to assign a “designated driver” if you carpool.

- Rt. 11 Potato Chip Factory (11 Edwards Way, Mt. Jackson, tel. 540-477-9664). Yes, there is such a place nearby. <http://www.rt11.com/> Watch potato chips in the making, try some samples, etc. This visiting spot has gotten rave reviews from visitors. Open 9 – 5 on Saturday, closed Sunday (not always frying – call ahead to find out.)
