Join Matt Webster, Director of Architectural Preservation and Research, Colonial Williamsburg Foundation; Ray Cannetti, Preservation Mason; and F. Carey Howlett, Conservator, for presentations and an on-site study of issues and current best practices for the most important task in preserving old buildings: keeping the water out. The workshop begins with presentations at Holley Graded School Museum and Art Gallery, lunch catered by the School Foundation, and an afternoon at nearby Wheatland Plantation to examine water-related issues, to learn about common misguided treatments that may cause even more problems, and to discover the best approaches to prevent water problems and to address damage to your home, church or commercial building. The day concludes with a post-workshop visit to Sabine Hall to examine a current stone restoration project.
