

Coming Soon: Washington Hospitality Grants

Application portal will open the morning of March 14, 2023

This program will award one-time grants to eligible restaurants, hotels, motels, and other small hospitality businesses in Washington State that were negatively impacted by the COVID-19 public health crisis.

Eligible hospitality businesses include:

- Restaurants
- Food stands, food trucks, food carts
- Caterers
- Bars, saloons, lounges, taverns
- Snack and nonalcoholic beverage bars
- Bakeries*
- Brewpubs, tasting rooms, taprooms*
- Breweries or microbreweries*
- Wineries and distilleries*
- Licensed facilities or premises of a beverage alcohol producer where the public may taste, sample, or purchase products
- Inns, bed and breakfast (onsite sales of food and beverage to the public comprise at least 25% of gross receipts or sales, or at least 5 private lodging rooms)
- Hotels and motels (except casino hotels)
- Bowling Alleys (Based on funding availability)
- Convention and Visitors Bureaus (Based on funding availability)

*onsite sales to the public comprise at least 25% of gross receipts or sales

A portion of the available funding will be set aside specifically to reimburse lodging establishments that experienced losses during the state's eviction moratorium pursuant to the governor's proclamations.

"Lodging establishment" refers to a hotel, motel, or similar establishment taxable by the state under chapter 82.08 RCW that has 40 or more lodging units.

Actual eligible losses include:

- Room charges not paid by persons who stayed during the moratorium,
- Any legal expenses incurred by lodging establishments as a result of the moratorium,
- and any repair expenses directly attributed to damages to rooms.
