Ministry Descriptions

Acolyte: Assistant to the clergy, performing ceremonial duties, specifically lighting and extinguishing the altar candles. This individual will wear a robe and will sit in front of the sanctuary.

Altar Care: Worship Assistant attending to all aspects of the altar area to include but not limited to the care of the linens, paraments and candles and the preparation and cleanup of the communion elements. This individual does not wear a robe and will sit in the congregation.

Assisting Minister: Assistant to the clergy, serving and leading the congregation in worship. Specific duties will be determined by the clergy. This individual will wear a robe and will sit in front of the sanctuary.

Book Bearer: Assistant to the clergy, specifically carrying the church's Bible during the processional at the beginning of the service and during the recessional at the end of the service. This individual will wear a robe and will sit in front of the sanctuary.

Bulletin Table Attendant: Worship Assistant who hands out bulletins in the Narthex as attendees enter the sanctuary and assists with any questions that arise regarding the informational material on the welcome table. This individual does not wear a robe and will sit in the congregation.

Communion Assistant: Assistant to the clergy, typically distributing the wine to the congregation. This individual does not wear a robe and will sit in the congregation.

Crucifer: Assistant to the clergy specifically carrying the church's cross during the processional at the beginning of the service and during the recessional at the end of the service. This individual will wear a robe and will sit in front of the sanctuary.

Greeter: Worship Assistant serving the roll of the first point of contact for attendees, holding the door for them, greeting them and assisting them with any initial questions they may have. This individual does not wear a robe and will sit in the congregation.

Lector/Reader: Assistant to the clergy, reading the 1st and 2nd lessons of the day and other parts of the liturgy when needed. This individual does not wear a robe and will sit in the congregation.



Multi-Media Assistant: Worship Assistant who oversees the livestream process of the worship service following the direction of the Music Director. This person does not wear a robe and will sit in the recording booth at the back of the sanctuary.

Mobile Communion Assistant: Assistant to the clergy, typically distributing the communion elements to the stationary members sitting in the congregation. This individual does not wear a robe and will sit in the congregation.

Usher: Worship Assistant who oversees the movement and the activities of the congregation during a worship service, assisting with seating, performing the offering collection, guiding the congregation during communion, monitoring the doors and windows and offering aid and guidance in an emergency. This individual does not wear a robe and will sit at the back of the sanctuary.
