Nature Study in Poetry

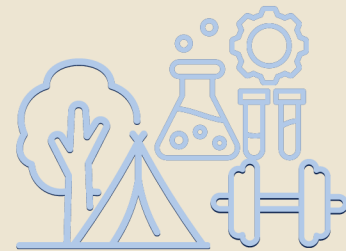

Descriptions

Young Debaters

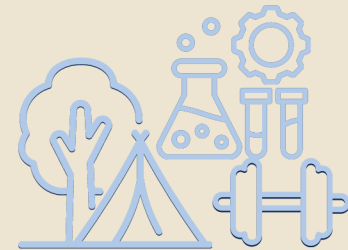
My First Food Truck
