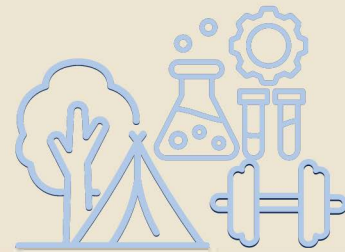
#### All Sports Camp

### Read All About It

### Flag Football

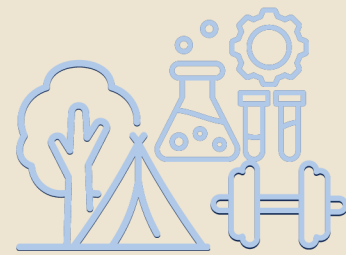
