Coordinators Network Roles and Responsibilities

Overview of Roles and Responsibilities of Network Coor Team

- Role of Network
 - Provide resources and opportunities for Coordinators to learn and grow in their role
 - o Create a sense of community among Coordinators
 - Uplift the role of Community School Coordinators
- Role of Coor Team Members
 - Participate in monthly calls and support a meaningful dialogue by asking questions, commenting, etc. Make at least 75% of all calls.
 - o Plan events/activities for the Coordinators network
 - o Engage in and encourage dialogue on the online community
 - o Plan the Coordinators convening at the National Forum (every other year)
 - Encourage other Coordinators to join the Network
- Role of Co-Chairs
 - o Recruit and help on-board new members
 - Check in with Coor Team Members to renew their commitments to serve
 - o Facilitate Coor Team Calls
 - o Participate in monthly Co-Chair calls
 - Facilitate network webinars and other events
- Role the Coalition
 - Send communications to Coor Team and the Network
 - o Recruit and help on-board new members
 - Coordinate regular Network activities (e.g., webinars, meetings)
 - o Create monthly newsletters and other eblasts to send to the Network
 - Represent the Coalition for Community Schools with announcements, updates, etc. on each call, webinar, or meeting
 - Connect the Coalition for Community School network members across networks and support network member with resources
 - Coordinate/facilitate in-person convenings at the National Forum
 - o Manage calendar invites for Coor Team and Co-chair calls

Coor Team Members' commitment to the serve

• **Co-chairs:** Will serve for (1) two year term with the option to recommit for one additional two year term. Max years to serve: 4

• **Coor Team members:** Will serve for one year term with a check-in each May to renew for an additional year.

Recruitment

- Co-Chairs
 - o Open nominations for new co-chairs will be held in February
 - Open elections will then be held in March
 - o Announcement of the new co-chair will be given in the April newsletter
 - o The new co-chair will join co-chair and Coor Team calls starting in April
 - Official transition will occur in May
- Coor Team Members
 - Nominations for new Coor Team members will be held during the spring/summer every year
 - o If there are more nominations than spots available, there will be elections
 - Required to have been a Coordinator for at least 1 year
