Skill level: Beginner

Video duration: 2 hours

Materials:

- 9" x 12" Strathmore drawing paper
- Micron pens (05, 1.0)
- Pigma Professional Brush Pen MB by Sakura



Single Block Projects: Quilt Block Pillow with Ashley Nickels

Skill level: Intermediate

Video duration: 17 min

Materials:

- Quilt block of your choice (Ashley demonstrates using Carolyn Friedlander's [Polk Block](#) - set of 4 blocks sewn together to create a 14" square)
- 20" square quilting cotton for back of pillow
- 3 ½" strips of quilting cotton for sashing
- 16" zipper
- 19" square pillow form
- Thread in coordinating color
- Sewing machine
- Zipper foot
- Snips or seam ripper
- Scissors
- Rotary cutter
- Clear gridded quilting ruler
- Cutting mat
- Pins
- Iron and ironing board

Skill level: Beginner

Video duration: 1 hour

Part 1 Materials:

- Coloring pages (see PDF)
- Colored pencils
- Pencil sharpener
- Micron brush marker

Part 2 Materials:

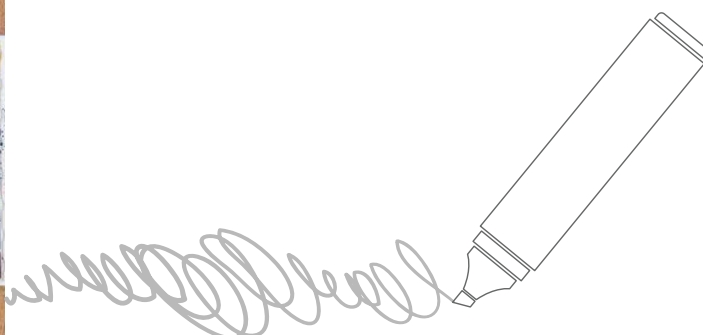
- Coloring pages (see PDF)
- Brush marker pens
- Gelly roll pens
- Glitter glue
- Highlighters

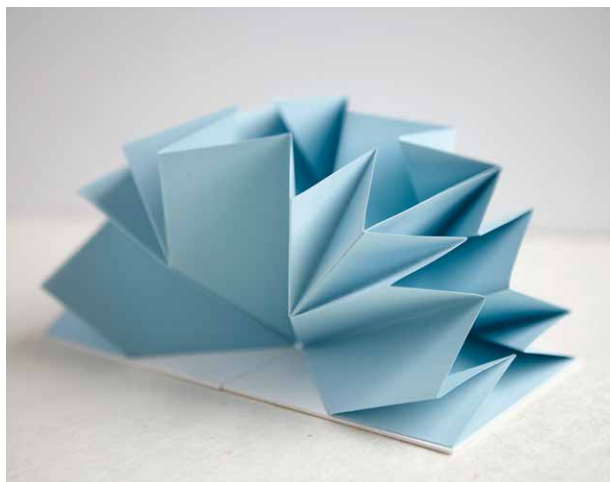
Part 3 Materials:

- Coloring pages printed out on a laser printer (not inkjet), so the lines won't bleed.

- Watercolor Pencils (Courtney uses Caran D'Ache and Stabilo)
- Water
- Q-tip
- Paintbrushes (Courtney uses sizes 6 and 2 round brushes)
- Wax crayons
- Pencil sharpener

- Pencil
- Any square paper that can be folded
- Glue (if attaching to a card or each other)

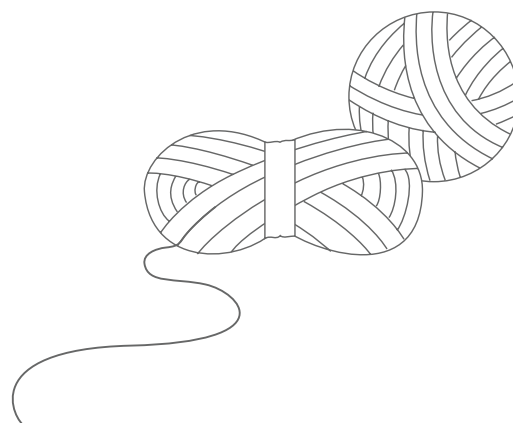
Skill level: Intermediate

Video duration: 20 min

Materials:

- 5 (7, 9) Balls RED HEART “Soft” in 4420 Guacamole
- Susan Bates circular needles size 9
- Susan Bates split lock stitch markers
- Yarn needle
- Knit Clips
- Scissors
- Crochet hook size I/9 (5.5mm) (optional)

Smocked Necklace with Liesl Gibson

Skill level: Intermediate

Video duration: 1 hour

Materials:

- Gingham fabric for practice
- Lightweight fabric for actual necklace (lighter than quilting cotton)
- Coordinating thread
- Contrasting thread for pleats
- Hand quilting thread
- Embroidery needle
- Thimble
- Embroidery floss in contrasting color to fabric
- Seed beads (optional)
- Small ruler
- Embroidery snips
- Fabric scissors
- Fabric marker or chalk
- Ribbon or jewelry chain with clasp
- Wire cutter
- Sewing pins



Fabric Fishing Game with Liesl Gibson

Skill level: Beginner

Video duration: 15 min

Materials:

- ¼ yd white/natural cotton fabric for front of the fish
- ¼ yd patterned or solid colored cotton for back of the fish
- Fabric paint in a variety of colors
- Paint brushes
- Scrap cardboard and masking tape
- Fish shape template pdf
- Pencil or fabric chalk
- Fabric scissors
- Hand sewing needle and thread
- 2-3 foot long ¼" dowel
- U-shaped magnet
- String for fishing rod
- Strong but small magnets for fish interior
- Straight pins
- Knitting needle or point turner
- Fiber fill stuffing
- Cup of water
