### How to Make a Blank Art Journal with Dawn DeVries Sokol

**Skill level:** Beginner

**Video duration:** 36 min

**Materials:**

- Hard cover book (to deconstruct)
- Cereal boxes (any size)
- Paper cutter (or cutting mat with X-Acto knife and straight edge)
- Bone folder
- Awl
- Binder clips
- Duct tape
- Artist masking tape
- Scrap papers for interior of book
- Scissors
- Waxed linen thread (or use dental floss or yarn)
- Binder's needle
- Large button
- Sandpaper

**Skill level:** Advanced

**Video duration:** 2 hours

**Materials:**

- Assembled quilt top
- Small scale drawing of quilt top
- Large heavyweight drawing paper (18" x 24")
- Tracing paper
- Copy paper
- Sharp Pencils
- Eraser
- Black marker
- Removable tape
- Compass
- Circle templates
- Template plastic
- Scissors
- Nail file
- Rulers: 24" x 6" and a variety of other sizes

**Skill level:** Beginner

**Video duration:** 1 hour

### Materials:

#### *For doll:*

- Three colors felt or glitter vinyl – thick material that doesn't fray works best
- ¼ yd midweight cotton or cotton/linen fabric
- ¼ yd or fat quarter quilting cotton
- Medium weight interfacing
- Marking tool
- Poly-fil stuffing
- Sewing machine with matching thread
- Iron and ironing surface
- Black polyester thread
- Sewing needle
- Metallic embroidery floss
- Fabric scissors
- Pinking shears
- Snips
- Paper scissors
- Glass headed pins
- Hemostat or large tweezers for stuffing
- Chopstick

#### *For doll (continued):*

- Sewing machine
- Iron
- Ironing surface
- ¼" hole punch (optional)
- Hem gauge (optional)

#### *For pom poms:*

- 25 yds of yarn
- Pom pom maker or cardboard

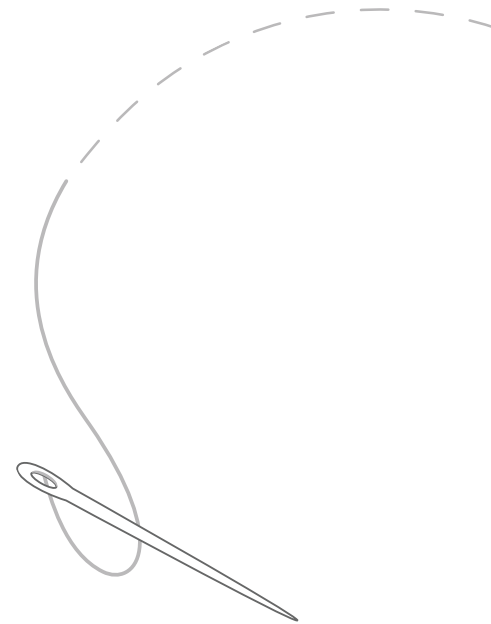
#### *For bow tie:*

- Medium weight cotton
- ¼" ribbon

#### *For dress:*

- ¼ yd lightweight woven fabric
- ¼" ribbon
- ¼" elastic
- Safety pin

### Pom Pom Garlands with Hello!Lucky

**Skill level:** Beginner

**Video duration:** 18 min

**Materials:**

- Industrial coffee filters
- Kitchen string
- Yarn needle
- Laundry line or length of rope
- Powdered fabric dye
- Drop cloth (optional)
- Rubber kitchen gloves
- 2 large mixing bowls
- Straight pins
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Glue gun and glue sticks



### Mosaic Knitting: How to Make Placemats with Edie Eckman

**Skill level:** Intermediate

**Video duration:** 43 min

**Materials:**

*Edie demonstrates the techniques in the class with a worsted weight yarn.*

- Cascade Yarns Ultra Pima (100% pima cotton, 3.5 oz/100 g, 220 yd/200 m), 1 skein each of 2 colors for each placemat. Colors should be highly contrasting in order to see the pattern. Each placemat takes just over 1/2 skein of each color, so you should be able to get 3 placemats from 2 skeins of each color. Colors shown are: (A) 3719 Buff, (B) 3735 Jade, (C) 3745 Bright Olive
- US size 6 [4 mm] knitting needles
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
