### Materials:

- Craft mat
- Paint palette
- Black ink pad

- Scoring tool

- Die cutting machine
- Heat tool
- Scissors

**Skill level:** Beginner

**Video duration:** 2 hours 28 mins

**Part 1 Materials:**

- Straight pen holder (wood or plastic)
- Pointed pen nib (Maybelle uses Nikko G pointed pen nibs)
- Black sumi ink
- Bottle for mixing
- White ink (Maybelle uses Dr. PH Martens bleed-proof white)
- Calligraphy pen rest
- Inkwells for black and white ink
- Black paper
- Lined guide sheets (see PDF to make your own print-outs)
- Vellum sheets
- Cardstock
- Envelopes
- Small vellum envelopes
- Lint-free rag
- Pen cleaner

**Part 2 Materials:**

Materials from Part 1, plus:

- 4" x 6" blank notecards
- Scissors
- Double-sided tape

**Part 3 Materials:**

Materials from Parts 1 & 2, plus:

- Small paintbrush
- Miniature spatula
- Empty jar
- Distilled water
- Jar label (optional)

**Part 4 Materials:**

Materials from Parts 1, 2 & 3, plus:

- Black masking tape
- 2 identical pieces of glass (for framing)
- Assorted papers
- Scissors
- White eraser
- Kneaded eraser
- Pencil
- Paint brush

- Pins

### Materials:

- 8 wool felt scraps
- 8-10 fabric scraps
- Cardboard toilet paper roll
- Frixion erasable pen
- Nylon neon twine or cord
- Scarp scissors
- Phoomph for fabric by Coats and Clark or double sided fusible interfacing
- Sewing machine and machine sewing thread



- 9x12 sketchbook
- Decorative paper
- Paper cutter (optional)
- Envelopes
- Labels
- Glue stick
- Mounting squares
- Washi tape
- Pens
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Family photos and drawings

**Skill level:** Beginner

### Materials:

- Notebook with a kraft paper cover (Lisa uses brown-paper Scout books but these come in a variety of other colors you might want to use)
- One or two colored Gelly Roll Pens that will show on the paper color you've selected
- White Gelly Roll Pen
- Black paper (Lisa uses a 9" x 12" sketchbook filled with black paper by Strathmore)
- White paint (Lisa suggests using watercolor from a tube, gouache, or acrylic white)
- Small paintbrush
