TampaBay Latin American Medical Society Scholarship

Students will be required to submit a statement indicating their qualifications including their depth of service and how this scholarship will alleviate their financial need.

Allen-Doubner Family Scholarship in Primary Care

RP Kaufman Scholarship

Charles and Bernice VanManen Medical Scholarship

Please submit a short response ~500 words essay expressing how you traveled a great distance in overcoming obstacles to get to medical school and then excelled in your 1st year of medical school through Education/Community service/Leadership.

Daniel and Lisa Almendars Endowed Scholarship

Please submit a short response (~500 words) expressing how you have demonstrated the ability to overcome personal hardship. Examples overcoming educational, social or family disadvantages. Ability, sensitivity and/or commitment to enhance communication between social and ethnic groups including gender, race, age, geographic origin, sexual orientation or economic status. Demonstrate through leadership or volunteer activities an understanding of the challenge of a diverse and changing society.

WB Copeland Senior Memorial Scholarship

Please submit a short response ~500 words expressing the challenge of independently financing your education without significant family support. Essay should highlight what receiving the scholarship means to you, any extenuating circumstances that would demonstrate how the scholarship would benefit you and help you achieve their goals.

Dr. John Sinnott Merit Scholarship in Medicine

Please submit a short response ~500 words that demonstrate your service in your community and the importance of community service.

MD Class of 2022 Sarah Ross Memorial Scholarship

Please submit a short response ~500 words on what "Don't Sweat the Small Stuff" means to you.

Riddle Family Memorial Scholarship

Please submit a short response of ~500 words explaining how you demonstrate a "Pay it Forward" approach to life.

Douglas Beldan Scholarship

If you consider yourself an athlete, please write a ~500 word response about how your involvement in athletics contributed to making you the medical student you are today.

Joy McCann Endowment for Underrepresented Minority Students

In ~500 words share how you demonstrate commitment to improving the health

of the community, including having a caring and compassionate attitude towards patients and their families.

Batra Family Endowed Scholarship

Submit a statement of ~500 words indicating your qualifications and expressing what activities including research, clinical work, volunteer work and any scholarly publications or presentations you have participated in demonstrating your efforts related to addiction medicine.

The Messina Family Scholarship for Excellence in Pathology

Submit a ~500 word essay explaining your background, interest in, accomplishments, or research in the field of pathology. Selected students will be based on demonstration of aptitude, excellence, or exceptional accomplishment in the field of pathology.

USF Judy Genshaft Honors College

Must be a member of the USF Judy Genshaft Honors college and write ~500 words on what professionalism means to you and how you intend to uphold an ethical culture of kindness and respect.
