
Theme: "Our local, natural environment." Student entries shall interpret the theme visually using their own style.

How to Enter: Submissions should be a color sketch and show all four panels (excluding the top) of the utility box (two panels are 30 ¼ x 63 in & two panels are 24 ¼ x 63 in). Sketches must be appropriate for public viewing. Concept should be one design that wraps around panels creating a unified image.

Deadline: Monday, November 5 at 4:00 p.m. No late entries will be accepted.

Prize: The winner will receive \$300 in art supply gift cards.

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Submission: Your entry must be enclosed in a sealed manila envelope and include the entry form below. There are two ways to submit your entry in person OR you may submit it electronically:

1. Drop off your entry in the Wilson High School Office during regular school hours (4400 E 10th Street Long Beach) addressed to Mr. Szeto. **OR** Drop off your entry in the Third District Office, Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. (340 Nieto Long Beach) addressed to Councilwoman Price.
2. You may also submit your entry electronically by emailing it as a PDF to District3@longbeach.gov. Make sure to also attach a completed entry form.

Deadline: Monday, November 5 at 4:00 p.m. No late entries will be accepted.

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Eligibility: The contest is open to all students at Rogers Middle School, Jefferson Middle School, Wilson High School, and 6th through 12th grade students living in the Third District.

Judging: The contest will be judged by Councilwoman Price, Wilson High School Art Department Chair and Faculty Member Mr. Szeto, and Project Coordinator Catherine of Girl Scout Troop 83. Their decision is final.

Requirements of the Selected Winner: The selected "winner" will be responsible for all surface preparation (I.E.: sanding, priming, etc.), providing the tools and materials, and painting the utility box on the corner of Nieto and Appian according to the concept submitted and selected. Acrylic paint is the only acceptable medium and the painting must be sealed by an exterior sealant appropriate for murals. The winner must be supervised during the surface preparation and painting process and the work must not take place during regular school hours. The project must be completed by 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, January 6, 2019.
