

## Sales and Use Tax Rate Change effective April 1, 2025

The Central Ohio Transit Authority (COTA) passed a permanent .5% (half of one percent) sales tax rate increase for all of Franklin County and those limited areas of Fairfield, Union, Licking, and Delaware Counties that fall within the COTA district **effective April 1, 2025**. Below are the new rates:
