Giving young people from remote areas of Myanmar the opportunity to go to high school.

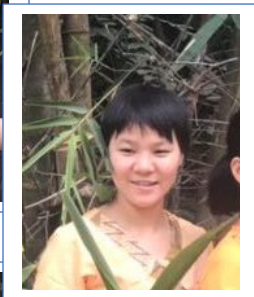

As children in Family-Based Child Care complete 8th grade, there will be those who want to continue into high school and even college. But there are no high schools, colleges, or job skills learning opportunities in far northern Myanmar. Destiny Home will be where they can live while finishing high school.

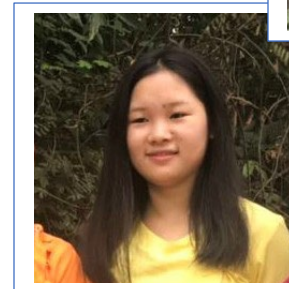

Pastor Lu’s Vision for Destiny Home

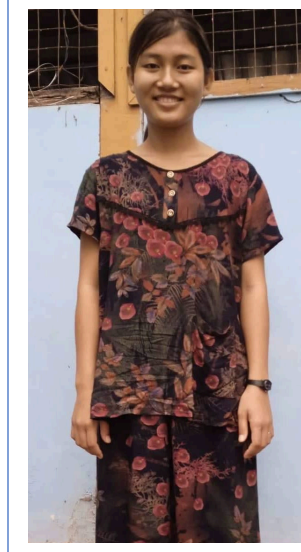
To one day add living quarters and staff to offer housing to young men wanting to finish high school.

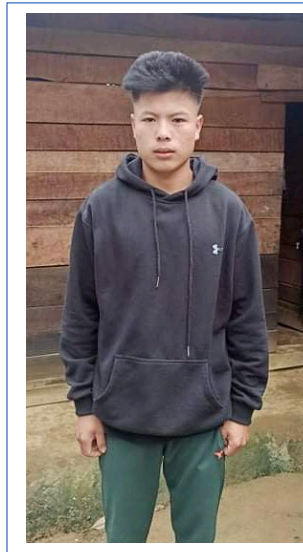
