Install GPS-enabled mobile maps on your smartphone or 3G/4G tablet

Install the apps - First, install the **Avenza Maps** app on your smartphone or 3G/4G tablet. The app is available free for personal use from the Apple Store (iPhones or iPads), or from the Google Play Store (Android phones or tablets). Then, install a free QR code app, like **QR Code Reader**.

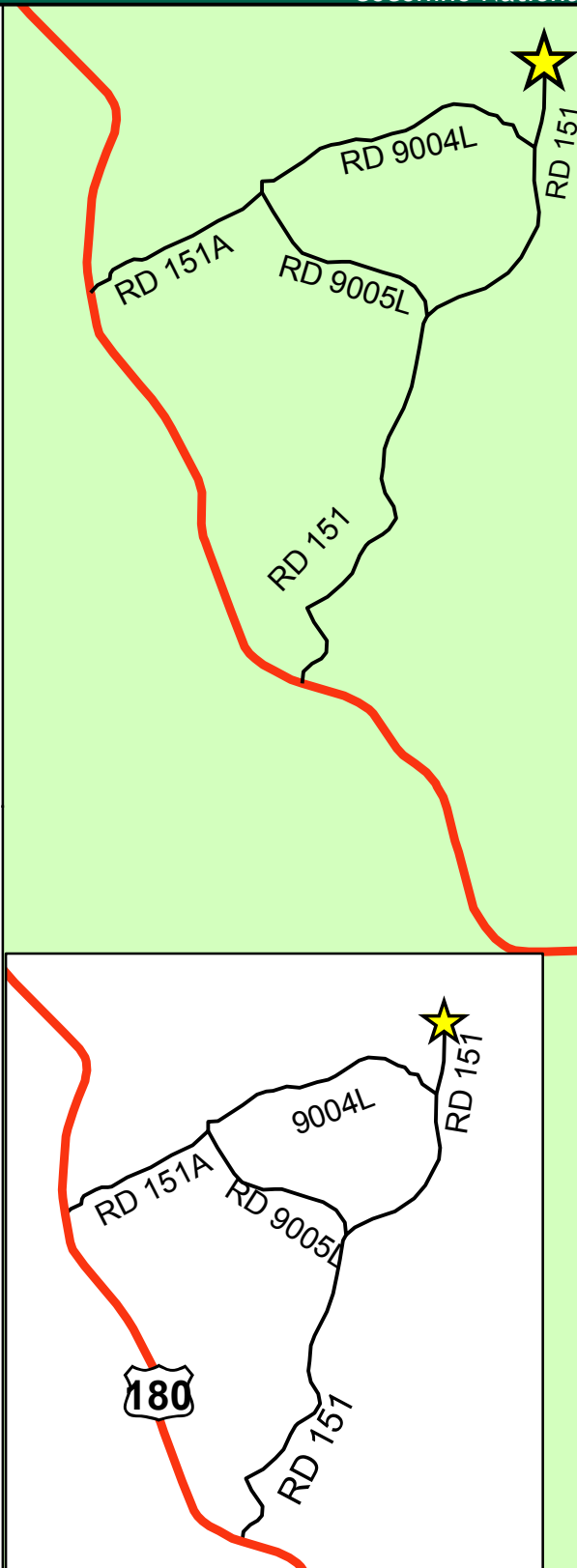
Install the maps - Download the appropriate map by scanning this QR code, and accepting the installation. A WiFi connection is recommended for this download.

Be aware there could be meadow restoration operations happening in the area with chainsaws and skid steers. Do not remove large down logs, these are apart of the restoration project and belong to the operator.



Directions: Take HWY 180 North from Flagstaff for about 9 miles. Then turn right on Forest Service road 151 for about 6 miles. The area will be on the left. Do not block Forest Roads.
