## Install GPS-enabled mobile maps on your smartphone or 3G/4G tablet

**Install the apps** - First, install the **Avenza Maps** app on your smartphone or 3G/4G tablet. The app is available free for personal use from the Apple Store (iPhones or iPads), or from the Google Play Store (Android phones or tablets). Then, install a free QR code app, like **QR Code Reader**.

**Install the maps** - Download the appropriate map by scanning this QR code, and accepting the installation. A WiFi connection is recommended for this download.



**Cost** - Map content provided by Coconino National Forest is free, but your wireless carrier may assess data service charges for non-WiFi downloads.

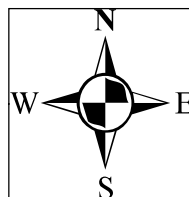

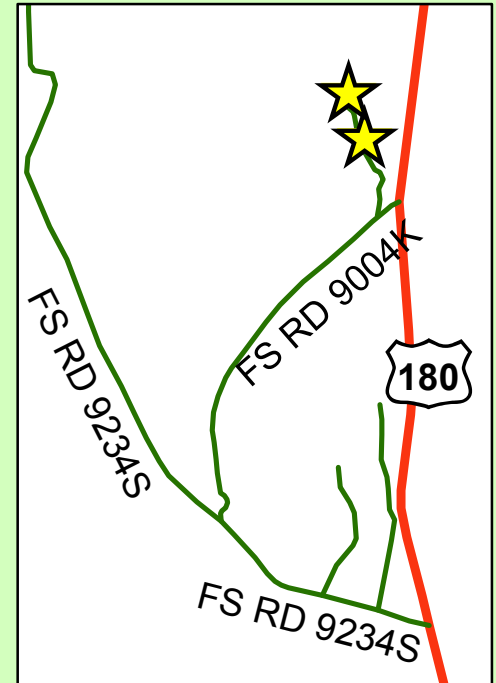

The HWY 180 free use area is comprised of two separate areas with material to be removed that have ponderosa logs, limbed, and laying on the ground.

**Directions:** Take 180 North from Flagstaff for about 14 miles. Then turn left onto Forest Service Road 09234S. Turn right on Forest Service Road 9004K and follow for about 1.5 miles until reaching cutting area on the right.
