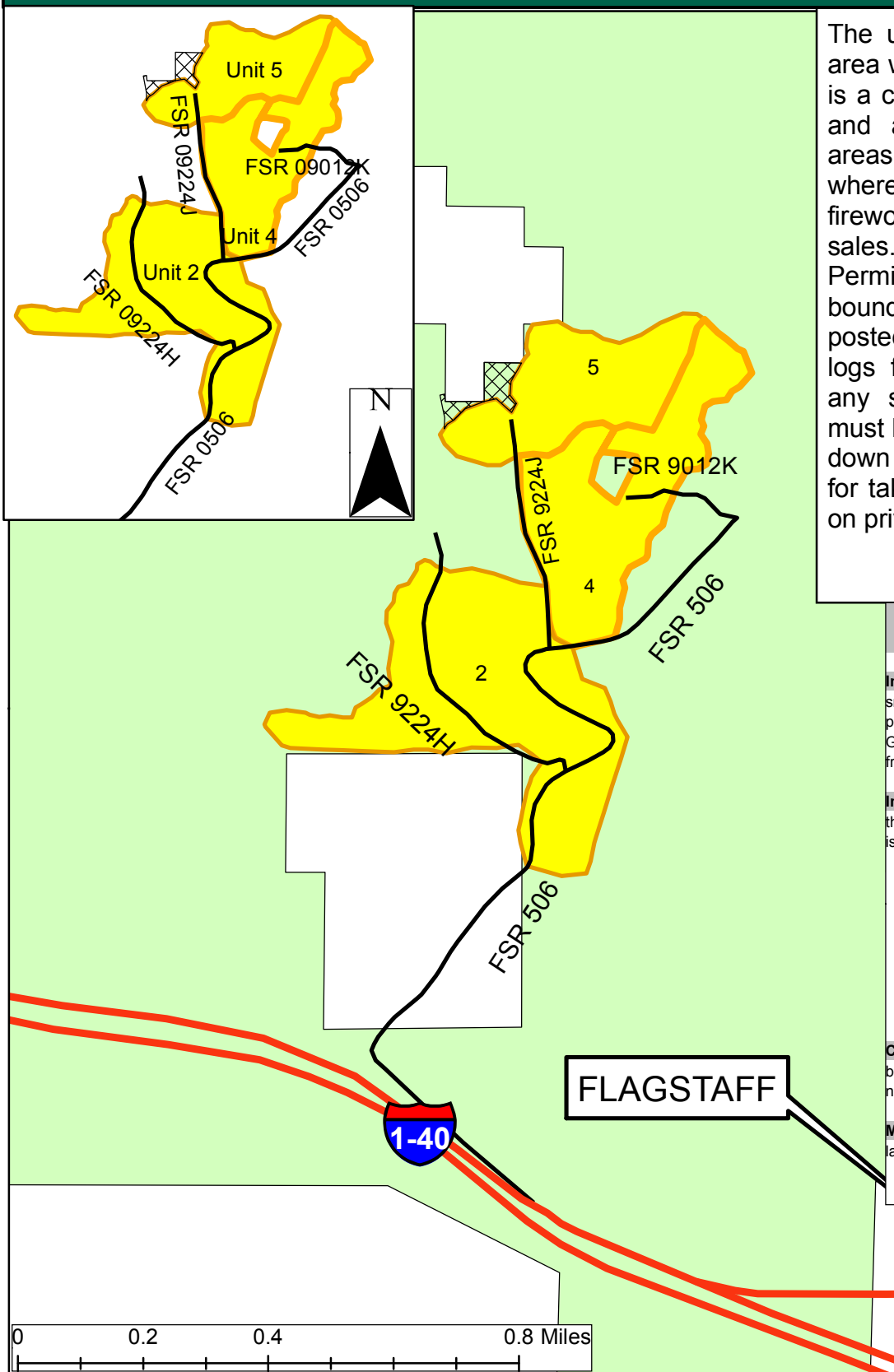


# Flagstaff Ranger District A1 Free Use Fuelwood Permitted Areas



COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST - SOUTHWESTERN REGION



The units within the free use permitted area were part of A-1 Timber Sale, which is a contract between the Forest Service and a private company. The permitted areas are adjacent to units under contract where cutting is strictly prohibited. No firewood cutting in active timber sales. The A-1 Free Use Fuelwood Permitted Area is strictly within boundaries of painted units 2, 4 & 5 and posted with fuelwood signs. Removing logs from slash piles is authorized but any slash resulting from your activities must be put back on piles. Only dead and down ponderosa pine logs are available for take in the Free use area, No cutting on private land.

## Install GPS-enabled mobile maps on your smartphone or 3G/4G tablet

**Install the apps** - First, install the **Avenza Maps** app on your smartphone or 3G/4G tablet. The app is available free for personal use from the Apple Store (iPhones or iPads), or from the Google Play Store (Android phones or tablets). Then, install a free QR code app, like **QR Code Reader**.

**Install the maps** - Download the appropriate map by scanning this QR code, and accepting the installation. A WiFi connection is recommended for this download.



**Cost** - Map content provided by Coconino National Forest is free, but your wireless carrier may assess data service charges for non-WiFi downloads.
