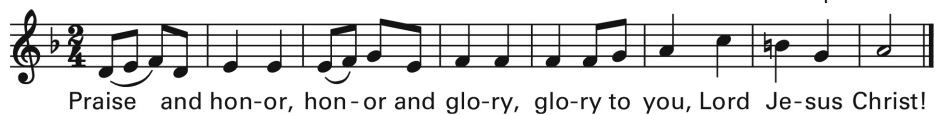



## An Act of Spiritual Communion





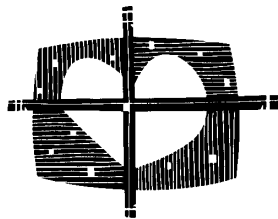
