- Rachel's father was a Baptist minister ("A very good and loving man, but I began to challenge the theology at an early age.")
- Rachel's first husband, David Caldwell, was pastor of College Hill during the 1990's. During this time, Rachel taught English at TCC. They retired to Mississippi, where David became ill and later passed away.
- During David's retirement, Rachel became an Ordained Commissioned Ruling Elder for the Presbyterian Church. Over the years following David's death, she preached in many pulpits, including one in Kilgore, Texas. She came to know the organist at the Kilgore church, who thought Rachel and Jerry (a member who had also lost a spouse) would be perfect together. ("He was absolutely right!" says Rachel.)
- Rachel and Jerry married in 2016, and at first split their time between their homes in Kilgore (where Jerry had been a physics professor) and Tulsa. Now living full time in Tulsa, the couple enjoys many things together—reading, cooking, traveling (most recently to the East Coast, to see Rachel's daughter), watching a little TV, and being a part of the College Hill family.
