



## Lake Charles Safety Message

Site Specific Training - Return to Annual Recertification

6 Month Grace Period

**To: All Service Providers**

**Date: August 2021**

During LCCP, Safety Bulletin 117 was issued (March 2019) that extended refresher training intervals for Sasol Site Specific Training Courses to three years.

Sasol – Lake Charles is reinstating the requirement for all Resident/Core and Non-Resident/Service Contractors to complete annual refresher training as specified in Safety & Health Procedure 1.30, *Contractor Safety, Selection and Auditing Program*.

Service providers in these groups are required to complete the following courses with the Safety Council of Southwest Louisiana or a reciprocal provider:

1. Basic Safety Training (Basic Plus)
2. Sasol Site-Specific Orientation (SASEN or SASS)

Sasol is providing a **six (6) month grace period** to allow service providers sufficient time to bring staff current. Starting **February 1, 2022**, contract employees in the above categories who do not have current certification cards (w/in 1 CY) will not be authorized to enter LCCC to perform work (except with escort per S&HP 1.30) until current.

*This does not affect Incidental Contractors who make deliveries of office supplies, service office equipment, vending machines, and others who have no opportunity to interact or affect a (PSM) covered process.*
