Public hearing for the Town Council to consider Design Review to allow for the new construction of the Winship Bridge. Design Review is required to allow the new construction of the bridge to be located within 25-feet of a creek, waterway, or drainageway. The Town Council will also consider the adoption of a Negative Declaration that has been prepared pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act.

The public hearing will be held at Ross Town Hall, 31 Sir Francis Drake Boulevard, at the corner of Sir Francis Drake Boulevard and Lagunitas Road. Copies of the Negative Declaration and the Plans are available for review during regular office hours in the Planning Department or can be accessed on the Town's website at the Frequently Requested Documents and Forms page link at www.townofross.org. The Town Council invites interested parties to submit written comments in advance of the hearing. Written comments will be received from January 3, 2020 through February 3, 2020 by 5:00PM and will be included in the Council agenda packet. Other written comments should be submitted at least 48 hours prior to the Council meeting so the Council has ample time to review the comments.
