Within walking distance, Copley Place and Prudential Center have a number of moderately priced restaurants, including: Sweet Green, The Cheesecake Factory, California Pizza Kitchen, Au Bon Pain, Five Napkin Burger, Atlantic Fish, and Champions (at the Marriott).

Boston has many more great dining options that are just a T ride or cab ride away.

GETTING TO BOSTON

Drive

The drive by car to Boston is approximately 45-75 miles from RI, depending on where you live.

GPS Address: 110 Huntington Ave., Boston, MA 02116

Parking at Copley Place Garage is \$37 per day (no in/out privileges). There are other local garages that may be a little less, but a longer walk.

Cost: Gas/mileage plus \$37 parking (\$37/one person, can be divided with more in carpool).

-Drive to Riverside Station, Grove Street, Exit 22 off Route 128, Newton, MA (approximately 45 miles from Providence)

-Take Green Line – D Train to Copley Place (inbound to Lechmere; outbound to Riverside)

Fare is \$2.75 each way; Parking is \$6/day or \$13/overnight. First trip 4:56 a.m.; last trip 12:05 a.m.

Cost: Gas/mileage plus \$6 parking and \$5.50 T fare (\$11.50/one person, less with more in carpool).

Commuter Rail

Take commuter rail from Providence, S. Attleboro, or Attleboro (Warwick and North Kingstown are options, but have less trains in the schedule) to Back Bay Station, 145 Dartmouth Street.

Fare is \$11.50 each way from Providence or \$10.50 each way from S. Attleboro and Attleboro. Parking is \$4.00 at South Attleboro or Attleboro (www.paybyphone.com). Back Bay Station is a short walk to Marriott Copley Place.

Cost: Gas/mileage, plus \$4 parking and \$23 train fare.
