2. All registered reps will receive a separate correspondence with voting rules and a link to vote.
3. The Officers' Reports which will include the proposed 2020-2021 budget will be sent April 10, one week prior to the assembly. There will be information on how to vote online to adopt the budget, as well as vote on the motion to change the submission date and deadline date of the WSBC application for the travel fund scholarship.
4. The other three motions to be brought up for a vote will be carried over to the Fall Assembly.
5. The PI/PO blitz submissions will be reviewed by the PI/PO committee, then their recommendations will be submitted to the board.
6. The three travel funds scholarships that were awarded, will be carried over to the Fall Assembly.
7. You are still required to serve on your Committee. The various committee chairs will be communicating with you about your committee work.
8. The Board will develop a method by which the convention raffle tickets will be distributed, and we will keep you informed.
9. If you registered for the Assembly with Lunch, you will be reimbursed after April 18.
