They are willing to participate in our process and will well represent the congregation of First Presbyterian.

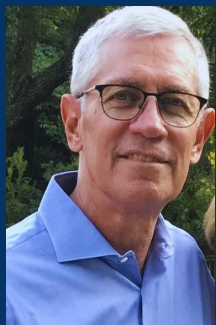
