
The Episcopal Church in Connecticut's Motion to Redact
List of Complainants

The Episcopal Church in Connecticut ("ECCT"), through counsel requests the Hearing Panel to remove from the list of Complainants in this matter [REDACTED] in the Discovery Plan and Scheduling Order jointly submitted to the Panel and subsequently issued by the Panel. In support of this motion ECCT states that [REDACTED] has consistently maintained from the time of [REDACTED] first interview with the Intake Officer that [REDACTED] did not want to be identified as a Complainant. Counsel for ECCT inadvertently listed [REDACTED] as a Complainant in the Discovery Plan and Scheduling Order jointly submitted by ECCT and Respondent to the Panel and subsequently issued by the Panel. ECCT submits that [REDACTED] should not be penalized because of Counsel's error.

Moreover, Respondent will not be prejudiced by the allowance of this motion. [REDACTED] was and remains a witness in this matter. [REDACTED] was included in ECCT's Mandatory Disclosure of Witnesses, and all documentary materials relating to [REDACTED], including the Intake Officer's report of her interview of [REDACTED] and the interview notes prepared by the Church Attorney and the Investigator, have been provided to Respondent's Counsel.

Wherefor, ECCT respectfully requests that this motion be allowed.
