



Traditional/On Campus Instruction

Beginning March 1st:

End Tracks/All students on campus every day; 7th/8th grades return to one classroom

Beginning March 8th:

1st day for DL students opting to return for On Campus Instruction

NEW Schedule Beginning March 15:

- TK 8:30AM - 12:00PM
- Kindergarten 8:30AM - 1:00PM
- 1st - 8th Grades
 - 8:30AM - 2:30PM M/T/Th
 - 8:30AM - 1:00PM W/F

Safety Protocols:

- Students exhibiting any COVID symptom(s) on campus will be sent home
- Siblings of any student exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 will need to stay home
- Students must be symptom free for 24 hours before returning to campus
- Active Screening: Arrival & Mid-Day
- All CDPH Protocols will be followed including:
 - CDPH protocols for hygiene, social distancing, seating, etc.
 - Masks will be worn by all students & staff on campus
 - Disinfecting frequently and extensive end-of-day cleaning practices will be followed; Additional deep campus & sanitization practices in place
 - Travel self-quarantine recommendations

Instructional Delivery:

- Teacher delivers daily instruction on campus
- Hybrid at Home (H@H)/Google classroom will be arranged for COVID-19 exposure, isolation of travel, and/or self quarantine students only (daily illnesses/absences will not have access to H@H Google Classroom)
- 1st - 8th grades will participate in PE as part of the instructional day

TRCS will deliver On Campus learning until health orders require or 5% total school population (staff and students) test positive within a 14 day period.

Distance Learning (DL)

Placement of Students:

- Parent request DL during open window enrollment
 - Final Window: February 24 - 28, 2021
 - Families may opt in or out of DL one time per school year

Instructional Delivery:

- Pathblazer 1st - 5th grades curriculum
- Edgenuity 6th - 8th grades curriculum
- Overseen by assigned teacher
- Instructional materials provided
- Intervention and excel activities provided
- Daily asynchronous instruction
- Teachers will have office hours and provide 30 minutes of direct daily instruction

TRCS ACTIVITIES IN BOTH MODELS

Speech, Intervention, Counseling, Designated ELD, and/or Special Education services will continue to be delivered via virtual meetings.

Students will have access to participate in enrichment/clubs and intervention programs.

All TRCS students will be engaged in the following (minimum) daily instructional minutes:
180 minutes (TK/K)
230 minutes (1-3)
240 minutes (4-8)
