Position Purpose:

This temporary position assists the Engineering section with engineering document creation and editing, equipment walk downs, equipment data collection, assisting with small projects, and helping with organizing and updating the drawing system. This position will also support the reliability engineering initiatives for the Laramie River Station (LRS).

Qualifications:

To perform effectively in this position, the incumbent must be at least 18 years of age and currently enrolled as a full time student in a four-year Engineering Accreditation Commission/Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (EAC/ABET) accredited mechanical, civil, or structural engineering program with the completion of sophomore year. A minimum of a 2.5 grade point average (GPA) is required. Good interpersonal skills, experience with personal computers and Microsoft Word, Outlook, and Excel; and the ability to demonstrate excellent written and verbal communication skills are also required. The incumbent must have a valid driver's license.

Typical Physical/Mental/Environmental Demands:

This position requires frequent sitting, and standing/walking; and occasional reaching below and above shoulder level, use of keyboard/computer, bending/reaching, kneeling, lifting/carrying up to 50 pounds, and pushing/pulling up to 20 pounds. It also requires finger dexterity and hand coordination. This position occasionally may work in conditions of dirt/dust, fumes, chemicals, extreme heat/cold, vibration, noise, poor ventilation, electrical risks, and confined areas. This position requires good hearing and vision, and the ability to speak. The incumbent may be required to work at heights up to 250 feet, which requires the use of safety equipment, including a harness, in accordance with ANSI Z359 standards. It also requires the ability to develop plans, procedures and goals; present information to others; and work under stress to complete projects within deadlines. This position must be respirator qualified and able to operate a motor vehicle.
