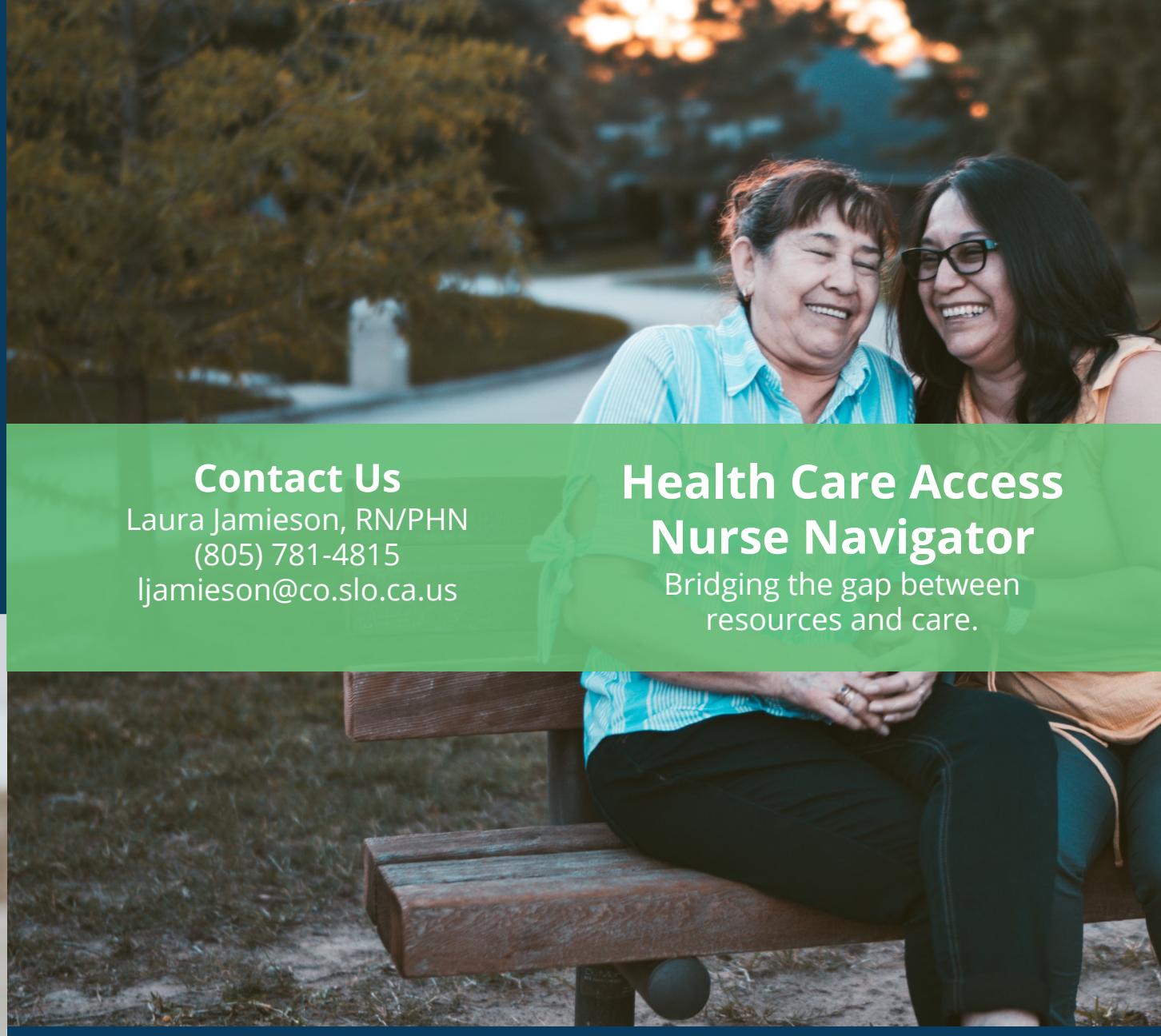


Why Navigators ?

- Find covered medicine through your insurance.

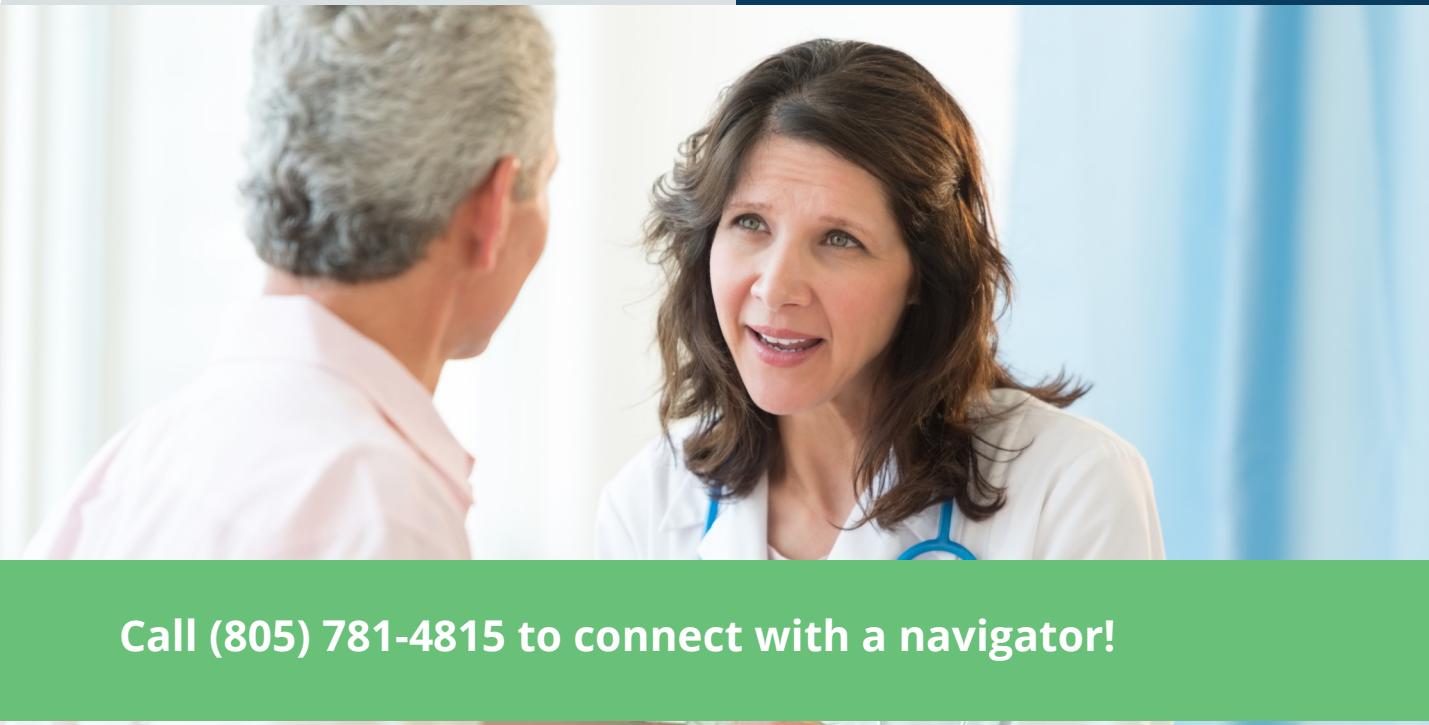


What is Health Care Access?
