



Frequently Asked Questions by Job Seekers

- Who should attend the Delaware Bio Science & Technology Career Fair as a job seeker?
 - Individuals interested in pursuing employment in science and technology industries are encouraged to attend. Jobs are available for individuals with Associate, BS, MS, PhD, BSN, LPN, RN degrees and career experience levels from entry to advanced.
 - Hiring employers are looking to fill part-time and full-time positions, as well as internships.
- What is required of me as a job seeker interested in this career fair?
 - Register by Wednesday, February 13, 2019.
 - Submit your resume to Yvette Murray at yvette.murray@delawarebio.org with the subject line, "2019 Delaware Bio Career Fair Resume" by Friday, February 13th.
 - Only one resume per individual will be accepted, and it must be in PDF format.
 - After registering online, attend the event at the Executive Banquet & Conference Center on Wednesday, February 20th any time from 3:30 to 6:30 p.m.
- Will you share the employers' contact information?
 - In accordance with our privacy policy, Delaware Bio does not provide contact info of any of the employers. We encourage job seekers to request this information from the employer(s) at the career fair, if they are interested in following up after the event.
- Is my resume shared with employers?
 - Yes, all job seekers' resumes will be shared with all employers shortly after the event.
 - If for any reason you do not want your resume shared, do not submit your resume. Please email Yvette Murray at yvette.murray@delawarebio.org to let us know you are attending the Career Fair but not submitting your resume.
- What is important day-of-event reminders?
 - Bring several hard copies of your resume.
 - Delaware Bio requests a copy of your resume at the entrance of the event, even if the resume was submitted electronically, to keep track of attendance. If you do not wish to submit your resume at the door, you will be asked to provide a business card or sign in.
 - Please plan to also have several copies to provide to the employers you are interested in.
 - Please dress in business professional attire.
