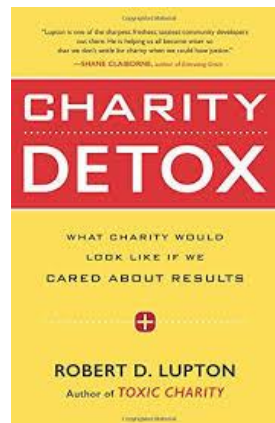
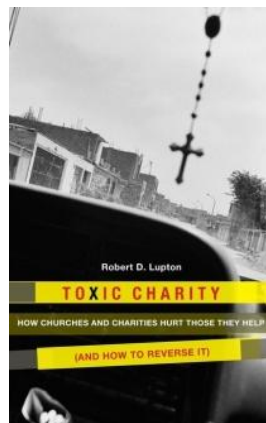

Reimagine Charity (Morning)

The Reimagine Charity Seminar is an introduction to the frameworks for understanding why certain efforts to address poverty are ineffective or at times harmful. The seminar introduces groups to the basic concepts of toxic and responsible charity. It is an interactive event that reveals why traditional charity paradigms are not working and casts a vision on a better way. By looking at real life examples, participating in thought-provoking exercises, and being exposed to compelling teaching, participants come away ready to chart a new course for a more responsible engagement with the materially poor.

Changing the Charity Paradigm (Afternoon)

The Changing the Paradigm has been built for groups that have read Robert Lupton's books, participated in the Reimagine Charity, or are simply ready to start changing the way charity is practiced. It is a workshop that allows participants to work through real-life initiatives and leave prepared to take the next, best steps into their charity.
