

TOWARD HEALING THE HARM

to participate in a one-day Zoom webinar on Monday, March 8, 2021 focused on healing harm that has been done to clergy women through gender discrimination and harassment in the Church. Those who have been harmed, as well as their allies, are invited to attend. Although the day will use clergywomen's experience as the particular lens, the training will apply to a variety of situations and contexts.

The day will include: worship; a presentation on our body's Fight, Flight, or Freeze response; and practical takeaways to help us feel prepared in the future. Our speaker for the day will be Ms. Rhonda Johnston, a licensed professional clinical counselor in the state of Ohio. She has worked extensively with survivors of trauma and is well educated in the many ways our bodies respond to situations of harassment and discrimination. Rhonda also has an M.Div. and can think and speak theologically about the effects of those types of harm.

You are highly encouraged to participate in the webinar with a friend or small group, in order to have others with whom to process throughout the day. If you would like help connecting with someone for the day, please indicate that on your registration.

Our day will begin at 9:00am and conclude at 3:30pm, with a break for lunch. After you register, you will be sent a Zoom link for the webinar as well as resources for home worship and journaling prompts.

This event was created in response to questions and conversations with clergy women from around the conference, and is a joint effort by the Bishop's Office, Board of Ministry, and Commission on the Status and Role of Women.
