Marine Resources Council (MRC) has selected the first inductees to the Legends of the Indian River Lagoon (IRL), a new hall of fame.

Jonathan Dickinson, shipwreck survivor who wrote firsthand about the Ais Indigenous People

Maggy Hurchulla, fierce southern lagoon environmental warrior

Dr. Grant Gilmore, Senior Scientist, Estuarine, Coastal and Ocean Science, Inc.

Paul Kroegel, leader in protecting lagoon's Pelican Island, first of 567 National Wildlife Refuges

Mark Perry, 30-year Executive Director, Florida Oceanographic Society

Nathaniel "Nat" Pryor Reed, leader in protecting 10 million acres of Florida natural lands

Jim and Jonnie Swann, philanthropic couple; leaders in responsible community development

Laurilee Thompson, fourth generation commercial fisher and staunch environmental leader
