LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT CANDLE OF HOPE

Today, we light the first candle of Advent and think about the hope that is ours in Christ. The prophets wrote of Christ’s incarnation long before his birth. As we hear their words, we remember our sin and our need for a Savior.
