Autumn Leaves for Your Gifts of 100

Back in January and February, the Centennial Commission presented the idea of how you can commemorate our 100th anniversary in a personal way – by committing to a gift of 100. You were asked to hang a green leaf with your promise on our Giving Tree in the narthex.

Beginning Our Next 100 Years of Discipleship

Ten Decades of History: 2000s

Terrorists in hijacked airlines strike the World Trade Center and Pentagon, while passengers force United Flight 93 to crash in Pennsylvania on Sept. 11, 2001. U.S. and allied armed forces invade Afghanistan in October to root out the al-Qaida terrorist group. The space shuttle Columbia explodes upon re-entry to earth orbit killing all seven aboard, Feb. 1, 2003. The U.S. launches a military effort to oust Saddam Hussein from power in Iraq in March 2003. Hurricane Katrina slams New Orleans, Aug. 29-30, 2005. The stock market plummets, and the economy plunges into recession in 2008.

Tryon reaches its peak population of 1,765 in 2000. Norfolk Southern suspends freight rail traffic through Tryon in December 2001. Passenger rail service ended in 1968. Tryon native Nina Simone dies April 21, 2003, in France at age 70. A memorial service is held at St. Luke's C.M.E. Church in Tryon June 21, 2003. The Lucianne Evans Jazz Quintet performs for the inaugural event of the Nina Simone Memorial Project Sept. 28, 2006, at Tryon Fine Arts Center. Polk County Middle School opens in 2005. Tryon Crafts purchases and moves into the former Tryon Middle School on Harmon Field Road in 2006.

TPC is recognized by the Presbytery of Western North Carolina Committee on Hunger in April 2001 for having contributed more than \$10,000 to the Two Cents a Meal program since it began in 1989. A five-year organ repair and enhancement project concludes successfully in 2001. Internationally acclaimed organ prodigy Felix Hell, 17, performs at TPC Sept. 21, 2002. Pastor David Hosick launches men's Bible and Breakfast monthly meetings in 2003. TPC celebrates the music ministry of retired organist/choir director Betty Brewer in May 2004. Lesley Bush is the new music director.

A group from TPC visits sister church El Mesias in Flores Costa Cuca, Guatemala in April 2006. Later that year, TPC agrees to provide scholarships for needy students at the El Mesias school. Beaver dams in the creek next to the church parking lot threaten to cause flooding in fall 2006. State wildlife officers remove the industrious rodents. The memorial garden is relocated from the front of the church to the bell tower area during 2007. By 2008, TPC is providing financial support for 59 students at El Mesias. Mike Carruth leads a TPC youth mission trip to Guatemala in June 2009.

August 2022 Session Recap

Ed Harrelson opened the meeting with a prayer from Isaiah the prophet.

The Property Committee reported on their research to repaint the bell tower in the Memorial Garden. They will be looking for a contractor to do the work to specifications outlined in the research.

The Session approved the next stage of work with the firm REI to draw up specifications and line up contractors for work on the replacement of the flat roof (choir, education, fellowship hall, and office buildings), repair of the concrete cross on the sanctuary, and exterior repairs to siding.

Denny Hill, from Personnel Committee, communicated the resignation of Susan Woodcock in her role as Director of Digital Communications. The elders expressed their appreciation for her work in both creating the Digital Ministry and expanding the church's digital footprint. It was the lifeline during the pandemic and continues to minister to the needs of many people. Personnel will work to update the job description and interview candidates. Susan will continue to remain involved as a volunteer.

Hill also encouraged the Elders to give feedback for staff performance evaluations which will held in September.

Worship Chair, Jane Grinde, had an excused absence but submitted the committee's report. The committee is glad to have Charlie Speight take the lead on ensuring the church bell is run prior to the start of service (9:55 a.m.). The bell will resume when Speight is sufficiently recovered from recent surgery. The worship leaders will process at 10 a.m. with the beginning of the prelude.

Hank Sibley, from the Chancel Task Force, reported on the committee's recommendation for choir risers and extension of the chancel floor over part of the stair case. The project was approved after discussion regarding attempts at trying to make the chancel handicap accessible. The ideas of lowering the floor and adding a ramp and the installation of a lift were explored without success. Half of the funding for the project already exists. Part of the funding includes the moving of the organ and piano from the chancel and the protection of the organ pipes during construction. Worship will continue in the sanctuary during construction that may happen in the 1st quarter of 2023.

Church Development Chair, Ed Harrelson, requested a meeting with the elders to preview the work of the Strategic Planning Team. Meeting will be held Sept, 6 at 5:30 p.m. Pete Bellamy offered to serve a light supper.

Fellowship Committee Chair, Pete Bellamy, requested input regarding a September meal for the church. Plans are underway, weather and COVID permitting.

Under New Business, Catherine Lynch, made a motion from the Centennial Commission that our Centennial Gift be made to Outreach for their affordable housing initiative. Motion passed unanimously. The congregation will receive information early in October about this special offering. The Executive Director of Outreach, Margot Carter, will give a Minute for Mission in worship. Gifts will be made in October and presented the day of the Centennial Celebration, October 23rd.

Susan Speight reported that the Membership Committee are planning a Trunk or Treat event for Sunday, October 29th.

The meeting adjourned with prayer. The next Session will be Monday, September 19th at 5:30 p.m.
