

Earth Kin Lughnasadh Ritual and Potluck Sunday, July 28, 3-5 pm

Join Earth Kin, our earth-centered spirituality group, on Sunday, July 28th for their Lughnasadh Ritual from 3-5 pm in Fellowship Hall. Lughnasadh (also called Lammass) celebrates the wheat harvest, and marks the transition from the growing time to the harvest time of the year, as it is the first of three harvest festivals.

After meeting in Fellowship Hall, we will move to the outdoor ritual space (weather permitting). For this ritual, Earth Kin will honor the harvest by creating a seasonal craft such as corn dollies and celebrating the rite of John Barleycorn so as to manifest certain energies in our lives.

This event is a potluck so please bring a seasonal dish or beverage to share, as well as a camp chair for the outdoor space.

Finally, if you would like to contribute some service to the UU Church and connect with the land, please arrive early (by 2:30pm) to help clear the outdoor ritual space of weeds and overgrowth (work gloves recommended).
