At this time, we have one half of the group assigned to a host family, so now we are looking for the second host family to complete their stay in Bloomington. Lotus Homestay HOSTS general request: A homestay host provides lodging/sleeping accommodations, in addition to breakfast and dinner during the dates the artists are in town for their residency for Lotus/Lotus Blossoms activities. If needed, Lotus can call on help for assistance with meals as needed. A per diem amount has been arranged as part of their contract to pay for their lunches during their residency dates of March 4-6. If a homestay host speaks Spanish, this is good to know, but not required.

DATES: MARCH 3-7

Arrival= Sun. March 3; Departure: Thurs. March 7 (early AM)
TOTAL Artists and Support Staff: 7 youth performers (6 boys and 1 girl), age range: 15-20yrs;
plus 1 faculty performer; 2 staff/interpreters =
10 people total (5 per homestay)

Half of the group is already accommodated. Still seeking:

Homestay REQUEST: 3 bedrooms for 5 guests

2 adults: 2 bedrooms or 2 beds/same room (1 faculty/performer, 1 staff speaks English/serves as interpreter)

3 boys: 1 bedroom (2 boys share queen bed) and have one air mattress or other set up (3 youth performers)
