

## Further Details on Recent Check Fraud Problems

If you mailed a check to UUCB in April, May, or June, and did not receive an email from us confirming that we received it, please contact your bank to see if the check has cleared. If the check was stolen, you should request that your bank investigate and refund the stolen funds to you. If it was stolen but not cashed, you can place a stop payment on it. We have reported this incident to the US Postal Service and the Bloomington Police Department.
