

What is A Living Rosary?

According to Maura McKeegan, "the devotion appears to have begun in France in 1826, when Venerable Pauline-Marie Jaricot formed the Living Rosary Association. She was inspired to pull together a group of 15 persons who would each be responsible for praying one decade of the Rosary each day, so that the full 15-decade Rosary would be prayed each day by the group. (At that time there were three mysteries of the Rosary, multiplied by the 5 decades.)

Over a century later, during the Nazi occupation of Poland, a young layman named Jan Tyranowski formed prayer groups of 15 men in this parish, representing the 15 mysteries of the Rosary. One of the group's leaders was the young Karol Wojtylathe young St. John Paul II (who would later introduce the Luminous Mysteries in his pontificate.) Tyranowski met with the men in prayer and guided them in spiritual direction. He called it the Living Rosary prayer group. Wojtyla, the future pope, remained devoted to the Living Rosary prayer group and brought this model into his own parishes after he became a priest."

During the month of May - the Month of Our Lady, St. Catherine's Montessori Community would like to form a Living Rosary prayer group to give honor to Our Lady and to ask her intercession for our community members as well as the whole world. This Living Rosary will begin on May 16 and end on May 31. We invite you to sign-up for one or more decade (s) of the Rosary at the slot(s) under this message and pray the decade once a day at a convenient time for you.
